CHANGE: Childcare and Nurture Glasgow East is hosting a workshop on Monday 3rd June at Parkhead Schoolhouse. The purpose of this workshop will be to share our proposal for an additional out of school care (OSC) service in Parkhead and to identify what support is required by existing services across our project area and North East Glasgow.

Who is hosting the workshop?

The workshop will be hosted by CHANGE and will include input from the Scottish Out of School Care Network.

Who should attend?

We would like anyone who has an interest in supporting children and families in North East Glasgow to attend. We would especially like to have people there from out of school care, Early Learning & Childcare, schools and other community organisations.

What is the aim of the workshop?

From the outset of the project, CHANGE has engaged widely with existing childcare providers, local families and other community organisations. We believe that in order for the project to be a success, it is important to include the views of all stakeholders, especially those providing services in the area.

This workshop will allow us to share our proposals for what could be needed to increase the level of OSC provision in the Parkhead area. There will be an opportunity for all stakeholders to provide feedback on this and to discuss the way forward.

We will also be asking services to identify what other support is required by those who are working with school-aged children. This will allow CHANGE to develop work plans up until October 2020 and identify where we can offer help to services across our project area.
